

## September 2011 Minutes

Jill Munos welcomed everyone to the meeting. And explained how the PTC meetings works.

Budget: First thing that was discussed was the budget. Balance: 10,341.05. We went a little over budget on the cookies purchased for Open House, but we have 663 children enrolled this year. That is something we will have to look at for next year. Planning on purchasing wood chips and padding for the playground. We have someone that is going to spread the wood chips. Teachers have suggested that we should review the money budgeted for field trips, we need to factor in the cost of fuel. The teacher were very appreciative for the new microwave that we purchased for them.

Thank you notes were read from Mrs. Naylor and Connie. Also thank you notes from the gift program students were read. We fund gifted program.

Next on the agenda was the Fall Fundraiser. Market Days fundraiser forms went home last week. There is no frozen food this year. Our target goal is 36,000 of which we get 18,000. This is the first year using Market Days for a PTC fundraiser. This is also the first year for the VIP. There will be drawings during lunch time. We are trying to come up with free incentives. The money drop was scheduled for Sept. 23rd but because of the High School Homecoming it has changed to Sept. 22nd from 3-7. This year is also a first for the prepay, we had problems with people getting products and not paying. Needed volunteers for the money drop. Virginia Treadway 3-7, Mrs. Naylor 4-5, Shauna Horn 4-7, Michelle Smith 5-7, Rachael Kuhl 5-7, And the PTC officers will be there too.

Next fundraiser Candy Bar Sale is scheduled for January.

Third on the agenda yearbook. Jill Matoush is over seeing the project. We have signed with a different company, Jostens. The yearbooks will be \$12 this year. They will not be hardback, but they will still be in color. The Jostens company gave us 2 Digital Cameras, the chargers, and memory cards. It was discussed how to check the cameras out, Jill Matoush is looking into it. Jill need a few more people to help her with this HUGE project. 5 people signed on to help out. 475 yearbooks were promised.

Fourth item was the Three for Me. Mrs. Naylor said to make sure you let the teacher know ahead of time if you are wanting to volunteer in the classroom. She also said that teachers love volunteers. Suggestions were sent home, examples helping with centers, take things home and cut, read with kids, make photo copies. About 275 parents have signed up. After September look on the PTC bulletin board for totals.
