Lincoln Land Community College - College Now program

College Now allows students to attend LLCC classes taught by LLCC faculty while still enrolled in high school.

College NOW PM students are released from the high school to attend LLCC in the afternoon (5th-7th hours) and earn up to 9 credit hours of college credit in the fall as well as the spring *.

College Now AM students meeting high school graduation requirements in December have the opportunity to attend LLCC full time (12+ credit hours) during the spring semester.

Students are required to meet standard college entrance requirements and are responsible to cover the cost of each course at LLCC's standard \$/hr cost. A list of available College Now courses will be made available each semester of its program.
