

2020 Homecoming Coronation Announcement

To remain in compliance with the current IDPH health and safety guidelines, we will be proceeding with the Homecoming coronation ceremony in the following manner.

Students/Court Members:

- Coronation will take place on the football field at 12:15 on Friday, October 2.
- The event will be live-streamed in real time to classrooms.
- The recording of the ceremony will be posted for public viewing immediately after its conclusion.
- All members of the court and senior class will be dismissed to the field at 12:00.
- Court members are required to wear masks throughout the ceremony when 6' distancing is not being maintained.
- Senior students will be permitted to attend and will be seated in the bleachers which will be marked to ensure 6' social distancing. Masks are required until all students are seated. An announcement will be made when it is safe to remove them. Any senior who prefers to remain in the classroom needs to notify his/her 6th hour teacher.
- Students are to remain seated until dismissed by announcement after coronation.

Parent/Family Members:

- Each member of the Homecoming court will be permitted 2 guests.
- Guests will park in the practice field and will be screened upon arrival.
- Guests have been randomly assigned a section along the fence to stand or sit (BYO lawn chair).
- Sections will be clearly indicated with numbers and names. If you have an **odd** section number, you will find your spot on the **North** end of the bleachers. If you have an **even** section number, your spot is on the **South** end of the bleachers.
- Guests are expected to wear masks any time 6' social distancing is not being maintained.
- Guests are asked to arrive no earlier than 12:10 and to exit immediately following coronation.
- Guests are asked to maintain social distancing amongst themselves and to avoid intermingling with members of the student body while on campus.
