Registration (required for ALL students, new *and* returning)

- ONLINE July 27 August 7 @ www.hillsboroschools.net (see online instructions on back), or
- IN PERSON Friday, July 31 between 10:00a.m. 6:00 p.m. at Hillsboro Jr. High gym

In-person registration is available for those who do not have computer access, or need assistance with the online process. It will take approximately 15 minutes. Your child does *not* need to be present. *If you do not register or contact us in regard to placement* by August 7, we will not be able to hold your child's spot.

Open House: Monday, Aug. 24, 10:45am-12:00pm, OR 6:15-7:30pm (for ALL Preschoolers, returning & new)

- Come & Go. You may bring your school supplies/donations at this time & explore the classroom with your child. Stations to drop your supplies will be set up in the hallway before you go to your classroom.
- Please <u>do not</u> arrive early, as Orientation for new families will be in session.

Bussing is only provided to & from school <u>Monday thru Thursday</u>. If you choose for your child to attend class on Fridays, you will be required to provide transportation that day. If you are unable to transport on Fridays or prefer your child only attend class Mon-Thurs, that is OKAY, and <u>will NOT</u> be counted against them. Please make a decision if your child will attend Friday Class this year, and let your child's teacher know by Open House. (If attending Fridays, regular attendance is expected each week.)
