To enable Flash to run correctly on Chromebooks:

- 1. Open the Chrome browser.
- 2. Once the Chrome browser is opened, you will see in the right hand top corner 3 dots stacked vertically. (Single click the 3 dots.)



3. This will open a dropdown menu where you will click on Settings.



4. Click on Advanced at the bottom of the page.
