The LaMoine Reeves Memorial Teacher Education Scholarship has been established by the family of Mr. Reeves. Mr. Reeves was a graduate of Hillsboro High School and devoted thirty-one years of service to the Hillsboro School District as first a teacher, and then a beloved principal, at Coffeen Elementary School. During his tenure at Coffeen, he was very proud to have been involved with the start of the District PreK Program. Mr. Reeves proudly served his country and his community. He was a United States Navy Veteran of the Korean War, a Donnellson Village Trustee, a member of the Coffeen Lions Club, served on the Montgomery County Health Department Board and the Hillsboro Area Hospital Board, and one of the founding members of the Educational Foundation. Mr. Reeves also played an active role in establishing the Coffeen Library. This scholarship is available to any graduating Hillsboro High School student entering the field of education.

CRITERIA

- Enrolled or accepted as a full-time student at an accredited college or university pursuing a major in teacher education
- Applicant must have maintained a “C” average or above at HHS
- Financial Need (cost of education, income, family size, unusual circumstances)
- Brief essay (one to two paragraphs, typewritten) detailing future plans and why you want to enter into the field of education
- Two letters of recommendation

AWARD

- One scholarship will be awarded annually in the amount of \$500.00, depending on resources available.
- This scholarship will be announced at the Hillsboro High School Honor’s Night by a member of the Reeves family.
