College Now with LLCC Litchfield

- Students can attend AM and/or PM Monday through Friday. Students earn both college credit and high school credit. Students are required to pay all tuition, fees, and book costs. Payment plans can be set up with LLCC.
- Benefits: earn college credits during your senior year that will transfer to MOST colleges and universities, reduce anxiety of transitioning to college, lighten your college load once you are a full-time college student
- Must be on track to graduate to take College Now courses
- Does not count toward required courses at HHS

Dual Credit Options

- Music in America – 1 semester Fall or Spring, Junior or Senior (LLCC)
- Psychology – 1 semester Fall or Spring, Junior or Senior (LLCC)
- ENG 2250 – Junior year long (SLU), ENG 1500/1900 (SLU -senior year)
- BIO 1240/1245 – Junior or Senior year (SLU - 4 credits)
