Mrs. Springer was a 1970 graduate of Hillsboro High School. After receiving her Bachelor's Degree in Elementary Education and Music, she returned to Hillsboro and taught for 31 years in the Hillsboro District. This \$1000 scholarship has been established by Mrs. Springer's husband, Dennis Springer, in her memory. The scholarship may be used for tuition, fees, and books and is awarded annually to a deserving HHS graduate. Because of her passion for music and the arts, priority will be given to students entering the fields of music, art, or elementary education.

CRITERIA

- Recipient must have maintained a "C" average or above.
- Consideration will be given to financial need.
- Priority will be given to students who were in the band or chorus and are pursuing a career in music, art, or elementary education.
- Two letters of recommendation must be attached.
- A brief typed essay must be attached detailing future plans (choice of school, field of study, and plans after completion.)

AWARD

- This scholarship will be announced at the Hillsboro High School Honors Night program by a member of the Educational Foundation.
- One scholarship in the amount of \$1000 will be awarded annually, depending on resources available.
