- Income of Student and Parent (25%)
- Cost of College Education (25%)
- Available Assets (25%)
- The recipient must be enrolled or accepted as a full-time student at an accredited college pursuing a major in education.

Only completed applications will be considered. A completed application includes the following:

- Cover sheet completed
- All questions on form completed
- Brief narrative included
- Two letters of recommendation included

AWARD

- These scholarships will be announced at the Hillsboro High School Honors night program by a member of the Hillsboro Educational Foundation Board of Directors.
- One scholarship is awarded in the amount of \$10,000.00, payable over 4 years to a graduate intending to go into teaching. Additional 4 year scholarships are available to applicants and may be payable over a 4-year period depending upon available funding. (This amount may be split between two qualified individuals selected by the Foundation committee.
