

2024 Hillsboro Educational Foundation Joan and Bernard Rappe' Memorial Scholarship

This \$500 scholarship is awarded annually to a deserving Hillsboro High School graduate who will be entering the field of Education in honor of Joan and Bernard Rappe'. Joan Rappe' served the Hillsboro School District as a choral instructor and director at Hillsboro High School and Hillsboro Jr. High School. Mr. Bernard Rappe' was active in community civic affairs, serving as Mayor and a member of the Hillsboro City Council for many years. Mr. Rappe' served on the district steering committee to build the new Beckemeyer and Coffeen Elementary Schools. Both Joan and Bernard received Service to Mankind awards from the Hillsboro Sertoma Club for their civic activities and for their service to the community.

Criteria (only applicants who submit a completed application will be considered):

1) Consideration will be given to the following:

❖ Class Rank (25%)

Demonstrated by class rank

❖ Income of Student & Parent (25%)

Family income, demands on income (family size, college cost, unusual circumstances).

❖ Cost of college education (25%)

The cost of college education is defined by actual cost minus any scholarships, grants, and/or financial aid awarded as determined by actual documentation from the institution the student intends to attend which accompanies the application. The application requires that the student and parents give information concerning any scholarships, grants, and financial aid that they are aware of or expect to receive.

❖ Available assets (25%)

The student will be required to submit the Student Aid Report (SAR – result of completing FAFSA).

2) Forms needed with application

- ❖ Most recent completed FAFSA form;**
- ❖ Documents showing costs of education along with evidence of grants, financial aid and scholarships;**
- ❖ Document indicating student's class rank.**

3) This scholarship is announced at the Hillsboro High School Honors Night.

4) The Foundation awards one \$500 scholarship each year (dependent on funds).
