- Leadership and involvement in FFA and/or 4-H activities
- Intent to pursue career in the food and agribusiness sector
- Proof of application or enrollment in post-secondary educational institution with an accredited food or agribusiness program
- Letter of endorsement from your FFA advisor, 4-H Club leader or academic advisor. Short essay describing yourself, activities involved in, your future plans related to food and agribusiness and why this scholarship would be beneficial to you

- Letter of endorsement from your FFA Advisor or 4-H Club Leader
- A copy of your current school transcript
