Each year the Greater Hillsboro Ministerial Fellowship offers a grant to one or more students who submit a "Faith in Life" essay. **The topic of this paper is to be the positive impact ones faith has had upon their life.** This may be in essay form, a poem, a song, or any other format you choose. In the past, typical entries have been one to three pages in length.

We guarantee a minimum of \$250 to the two selected essay writers. The money may be used for any purpose related to your further education.

The entries are assigned a number, have the names removed, and are then sent off to a reader outside our school district. Past readers have been people who work with High School teens.

Your entry must be submitted by no later than Sunday, May 10th by emailing a copy to Rem Dyas at remdyas@gmail.com or to Matt Ferguson at pastorferguson@hotmail.com

Be sure your entry has your name on it and contact information (phone number and/or email address). A copy, with your named removed, will be sent to the person who will do the reading/selection.

The people whose entries are selected are asked to be available to read their entry at this year's Baccalaureate service, held the evening prior to graduation. (We do not know if we will be holding an in-person Baccalaureate service or not this year due to the Shelter-In-Place order.) In past years the Faith In Life essays that are selected have been re-printed by the Hillsboro Journal as part of their graduation edition.
