The Department of Accounting and Finance is pleased to announce an exceptional scholarship is available to an incoming freshmen for the 2019-2020 academic year. This scholarship is a progressive scholarship award, beginning with \$2000 in the first year; \$3000 in the second year; \$4000 in the third year and \$5000 in the fourth year if the student meets the maintenance requirements each year. Funding will be disbursed ($\frac{1}{2}$ fall and $\frac{1}{2}$ spring).

Initial Scholarship Criteria:

- Entering WIU as a Freshman in Accounting
- Cumulative High School GPA of 3.0 or above on a 4.0 scale
- Evidence of Community Service
- Demonstrated Financial Need using the FASFA

Maintenance Criteria:

- Continue as an Accounting Major
- Maintain a 3.0 or higher Accounting and Cumulative GPA
- Participate in Accounting program student group activities
 - The Student Chapter of the IMA
 - The Zeta Beta Chapter of Beta Alpha Psi
- Demonstrated Financial need using the FASFA
- Remain active in community service
- Remain a student in good standing
