CRITERIA

- Two letters of recommendation must be submitted with the application
- Brief essay detailing future plans (choice of school, major concentration, plans after completion) must be submitted with the application
- Completion of all pages of the application

AWARD

- The scholarship will be announced at the Hillsboro High School Honor's Night program by a member of the Singler family.
- One \$1000 scholarship will be awarded annually, depending upon resources available.
