This award is presented to a deserving Hillsboro High School graduate through the generosity of 1950 HHS graduate Dr. Lawrence (Larry) Mormino of Cary, NC. Dr. Mormino established this scholarship to provide graduating Hillsboro High School Seniors with an opportunity to obtain higher education in the field of their choice. While at HHS, Mr. Mormino was active in the Hiltop yearbook, student council, Spanish Club, Latin Club, football, track, basketball, and baseball. With 1,550 career points, he remains the boys' points leader. Larry Mormino attended Bradley University where he earned a four year scholarship and participated in the NIT. He graduated with a degree in mechanical engineering. He entered the Air Force and was trained as navigator in a C-130 transport plane, transporting cargo to troops in the war zone.

Mr. Mormino earned a Ph.D. from St. Louis University in 1980 with a degree in education. He spent the rest of his career teaching at North Carolina State University as a Professor of Aerospace Science in the ROTC Program. He fondly recalls his years at Hillsboro High School.
