MEDICAL PROVIDER CO-PAYS

Cross Over Ministries' Provider Co-pay program will assist you in getting mental health treatment when you need it most by covering Medicaid and Private Insurance co-pays. If you do not have medical insurance we may be able to help. Our goal is to ensure that everyone has access to care regardless of their ability to pay.

PHARMACEUTICAL CO-PAYS

Cross Over Ministries has partnered with local pharmacies to ensure that you have access to an approved list of commonly prescribed medications an individual needs to maintain their mental health and wellness. Our goal is to ensure that everyone has access to these medications regardless of an individual's ability to pay.
