
HISS meets at the Montgomery

Time will also be set aside for fun/social interaction that will allow the kids to develop the skills they need as well as develop some peer supports.


At times, outings will be planned to allow the kids to practice these skills in the community. We also present classes on topics such as hygiene, safety, and interpersonal skills.

You know how sometimes you feel like you just don't fit in?




How some days it feels like no matter how hard you try, nothing you do is right?
