

ultrasound scanning

An ultrasound can give you information about your pregnancy that a pregnancy test alone cannot provide and is necessary to rule out a possible miscarriage or ectopic pregnancy.

Under the supervision of a medical doctor, our trained nurses provide limited obstetrical ultrasounds to determine if your pregnancy is viable by finding the location of the pregnancy, detecting heart activity, and estimating gestational age.
