

- 8. Comprehensive counseling to assist homeless with transition to permanent housing
- 9. Provides help with winter heating bills. One time payment. Normal eligibility is 125% of the poverty guidelines.
- 10. One on one tutoring, including English as a second language, work place literacy, computer learning centers, family literacy and literacy in county jails
- 11. Provides meals for shut.ins in the Hillsboro Area. Available to any senior or handicapped person in the Hillsboro Area. \$1-5 per meal payable to the Hillsboro Nursing and Rehabilitation Center. Available Monday through Friday at noon meal.
- 12. Helps seniors with insurance and Medicare Problems, filling out forms

13. Provides attic, sidewall and/or floor insulation, proper venting for attics and crawl spaces, caulking, weather stripping, broken glass replacement. Available to homeowners and renters who meet the income guidelines 14. For those low income seniors over age 65 or low income individuals at least 16 years on total disability. Assistance filling out forms.
