A student needs 25 credits to graduate and must include the following:

4	Physical Education
1	Elective (Music, Art, Foreign Language, Vocational)

In addition, all students must take and receive a passing grade on the United States Constitution test.

The following are guidelines for registering for Classroom Driver's Training Classes (CDT):

Reminder a student must pass 8 classes in two consecutive semesters to be eligible for CDT and PDT. If in junior high, then at least 4 of the 5 academic classes (Literature, Language, Math, Science, Social Studies) MUST BE PASSED. PDT enrollment will be based on passing CDT and remaining academically eligible.
